**5.0 Annual Title I Parent Meeting**

- *Our campus is currently grandfathered into T1 this year. It has to be 75% (Currently 74.3% when last pulled in 12/1.) T1 is federal money. KCES is currently using T1 money for staffing two teacher positions and one teacher position @ 60%. We are also using funds for scholastic books for students.*
- *PARENT SURVEY: Only 13 parents participated. 92.3% of respondents feel welcome, and 84.2% think that the school values their input.*

**7.0 Emergency Procedures**

- *KCES completed our first fire drill of the year. The drill was a success, including the 40 new preschool students who were added to our campus.*
- *We completed a Secure from the SRP that CCSD Police issued due to an issue nearby, but off campus. Students watched a video about SRP Standard Response Protocols to educate them about the terms and their responsibilities when the SRP issues a command. Mrs. Lawrence went over each procedure with the students after the video was shown. Our campus is staffed with an emergency support team that responds to emergencies here on campus.*
- *Our campus has a fire drill every month. We will also complete three lockdowns, two secure, one shelter in place, and one earthquake drill this year.*

**8.0 Asphalt Resurfacing**

- *Kiss N GO has been completed. We are currently in the middle of the front parking lot. Staff and guest parking will reopen Thursday morning. The entire blacktop will also be redone. The blacktop will be completed over the next several weeks, broken into different sections until finished. Once the asphalt is done, the parking lot and playground will also be restriped and painted. We will have new options and games on the blacktop, including color-coated sections on the playground. The new options will include a trike track on the Kindergarten side, hopscotch, catch it, and three Kelso Choice wheels.*

- *Mrs. Stout - Inquired about why parents can no longer U-Turn at Kiss N Go. IT WAS DUE TO BEING A LAW. THERE WAS ALSO SEVERAL ACCIDENTS THERE LAST YEAR IMPACTING THE SAFETY OF STUDENTS AND STAFF.*
- *Mrs. L Cruz - Inquired about adding speed bumps. THAT IS NOT CURRENTLY IN THE PLANS.*
- *Mrs. Piplic - Inquired about sending safe route videos to parents via Class Dojo. - THIS MAY BE AN OPTION.*
