- 10.0 School Liaison-What have been the first 30 days action steps...- Jennifer Lamontagne -checks on attendance (absences and tardies), runs attendance groups, calling parents and introducing herself, home visits, assists with attendance recognition
- 11.0 Attendance and MAP DATA any correlation? Angela Reinhard -Mrs. Reinhard went over MAP data in relation to chronically absent. The less time students spend in the classroom, the lower their performance on assessments.
