4.0 Count Day/ Enrollment

KCES is ahead by 46 students from projected enrollment, but this is not the case.

5.0 Budget Update- if available

■ We have lost \$17,200 of Title 1 funds. CCSD reduced all T1 schools by 6% due to deficit funding across the district. We are currently paying two teacher salaries and one teacher at 62% of the full salary. With the reduction of funds, the third salary will be reduced to 27% with the remainder coming from the general budget. Due to higher-than-projected enrollment, we will be hiring an additional kindergarten teacher. The projected allocations will be discussed with the central office on Friday.

6.0 MAP Growth Data

■ We completed MAPS testing two weeks ago—53% per national norms with Math and 58% with ELA. KCES scored higher this fall than last fall.

7.0 Data update for School Plan of Operation

■ Due to changes with MAPS we are adjusting the SPP of increasing student scoring above the 41%percentile from 68% in Math to 73% Winter/78% Spring. For ELA it will be 77% Winter/82% Spring.

8.0 SOT Elections opens September 10

We will skip the SOT Election as we need five volunteers, but we only have five volunteers signed up.
