Annual Policy Meeting and Distribution

Kay Carl Elementary School will convene an annual Title I meeting on August 19, 2025 to review, revise, and approve the Parent and Family Engagement Policy. District-Wide Parent Survey

To encourage participation, a Class Dojo reminder about the survey will be posted during Parent Conference Week.

Results will be:

- Shared on the school website
- Reviewed with the SOT
- Used to implement changes in the 2025–2026 school year
 - Results: Thirteen parents responded to the survey last spring. 92.3% of the respondents stated they feel welcome at school, KCES involves them in most school activities, and that we do a good job at preventing bullying. 84.62% of respondents stated KCES really values my input and opinions. The lowest marks were for questions that asked about the District as a whole and communication/transparency.
 - We have used these results to help continue our school activities that we have completed in the past. We will also continue to communicate with parents over the phone, through dojo, and parentlink about what is happening within the school/CCSD.

Student and Community Feedback

- Students will be rewarded through the Score Store for MAP growth.
- Parents and staff may voice concerns at monthly SOT meetings to improve the school community.

 - Materials that are a part of Parent Training Nights will be offered in a handout/f;yer form for families to take, so they can implement strategies at home. If it is an activity, all materials for that activity are provided to families when they attend.
